

Tender No. T5/2009 – Request for Tender for Laboratory Analysis of Water Samples Collected within Hornsby Shire

Tenders are invited and will be received up to 10.30am on Wednesday 6 May, 2009 for proposals from suitably qualified and experienced service providers to facilitate the continuation of Hornsby Council's water quality monitoring program.

Services will be required for three years with an option to extend for one extra year. The main requirements will be: (1) provision of bottles, cooler boxes and courier service, and (2) analysis of water samples for bacterial contaminants (faecal coliform and enterococci) and chemical constituents including nutrients, suspended solids, chlorophyll-a, trace metals, BOD and other common analytes.
